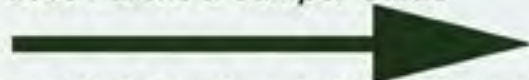

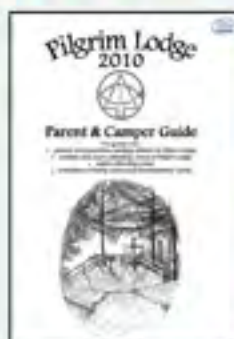

| Apr. 23-24 | adults & youth | <i>Jump Start Work Days</i> | It's our camp! Volunteer to open camp for the weekend. This is a work weekend. Youth (6th grade and above) need adults with them. Free Friday overnight, Sat Breakfast and lunch. Details online or by phone. No charge |
| Apr. 24-25 | church youth groups | <i>Youth Group Overnight</i> | If your group works on Saturday (see above) stay for free, with supper on Sat. and breakfast on Sun. Groups stay together by cabin with a 1:7 adult to youth ratio covering both genders. Details on the web. \$25 if you don't work. |

| May 28-31 | committed couples | <i>Couples Who Pray</i> | Take time apart as a couple. Morning and evening worship, spirituality for partners, labyrinth time, any of these can be a part of your weekend. Our time will be what you make it, shared with other couples on holy ground at PL. \$125 |
