We are planning on providing opportunities for people to share in the following activities:

\* We have a new craft this year. Making crocheted items out of plastic shopping bags. If you want to participate we ask that you bring with you: Different colored plastic bags and a crochet hook (medium size or a variety). If you have a cutting board and rotary cutters that also would help. \* Portland will start charging .05 cents for paper and plastic bags in April 2015. Joan will bring a few sewing machines and material to make shopping bags to give to their food pantries. If this is something you would like to do and you have a sewing machine and scissors bring them along.

\* Zentangles on a variety of surfaces with a variety of media. Zentangles are a form of Zen doodling. Allie will bring some supplies, but you are encouraged to bring a fine and extra-fine black Sharpie, Sharpies in all colors and any paint markers you might have hanging around. If you have some plain ceramic mugs, plates, candle holders, smooth light-colored stones (small) white shells, and anything else that a Sharpie will mark on, bring 'em too!

\* Washer Art. Hmm... how do we explain this? Well, Marden's in Scarborough has a huge supply of all sizes of washers in the hardware section (cheap by the pound) and with a little nail polish or paint marker they can make some pretty awesome jewelry or wind chimes. Allie will supply some washers but has not used nail polish since high school, so bring your own in as many colors as you can find! Also, some jewelry cord or fine decorative wire, and beads.

\*Making indoor snowballs. Joan will supply the material for you to make them. Then we will have an indoor snowball fight before we leave.

We will have our talent show again so dust off your tutus or vocal cords. Our auction this year will be for the benefit of the PL Capital Campaign so bid high and often and bring something that people will fall over themselves to buy.
