THE GOOD RACE

I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. - Philippians 3:14

Much of camp, and of ministry feels like a race. A race against deadlines, replete with personal standards, and a commitment to make it happen no matter what comes along. Every year while getting camp together there are moments when I'm not quite sure if we're going to make it. The deadlines are hard and fast. Every year I have this disquieting fear that this is the year I'm not going to make it in time for the camp brochure, the online registration debut, the deans' retreat, the staff hiring process, all the details that need to come together before camp opens. Regardless of the lead-time and work I put in, I often end up pulling an all-nighter, or working through meals, or calling in help to get it done. And as I worry about the deadline, there is almost always someone who says to me "don't worry, it always gets done somehow."

That voice. That confidence. I should believe it because - it *does* always get done somehow. So here we are, fast approaching another deadline, the completion of the active fund raising part of the capital campaign. And we are so close! By any measure, this campaign is already a success, thanks to the hard work of so many dedicated people and the generosity of each donor. But we're still about a \$130,00 from the goal and the finish line is the end of this month.
