On Sunday, July 21, the day you come to camp, please arrive between 2:00 and 4:00 p.m. When you first arrive at PL, you will be greeted by camp staff who will show you or your driver where to unload your bags, park the car, and find us to get signed in for the week. You'll then check in with the camp staff, the nurse, and then us! We'll be waiting to greet you and tell you what cabin you will get to stay in. You can then head to your cabin, meet your counselor, and set up your bunk...and the fun begins! Your family can stay and help you get settled into your cabin until 4:00.

On Saturday, July 27, the last day of camp, your family will pick you up between 9:30 and 10:30 am. Beginning at 9:30 we will be having a special closing program down by the waterfront.
