Why do I see three prices listed?

Realizing that families have different abilities to pay, Pilgrim Lodge has instituted a voluntary three-tier fee program. Tier 1 reflects the actual cost of providing a week of camp at Pilgrim Lodge, Tier 2 is a discounted rate, but still closely accounts for the costs of camp, Tier 3 is our historically subsidized range and does not reflect all costs of operating our summer camp programs and site. Please choose the tier that is most suitable for your family.

If at all possible for you, Tier 1 and Tier 2 will help us assure that Pilgrim Lodge is sustainable for future campers! All campers receive the same Pilgrim Lodge experience regardless of what tier is chosen. For those families that cannot afford Tier 3, additional financial assistance is available to ensure that everyone has the wonderful opportunity to attend camp.

Are discounts available?

Bring a Friend! If you want to bring a friend who has never been to PL before, you and your friend can each receive a \$50 discount (\$25 for adult and half week sessions).

Multiple Session Discount (for full-week youth sessions only) If a camper attends more than one full-week session in the same season, that camper is eligible for a \$100 discount.

Are scholarships available?

Yes, for those families that cannot afford Tier 3 additional financial assistance is available. The deadline for scholarship applications is May 15. If you are currently attending a church, please ask your pastor if additional support is available from your church. How do I register?

The quickest and easiest way is on our website: www.pilgrimlodge.org A non-refundable \$100 deposit is required to process your registration (\$50 for shorter sessions). The balance is due by June 15. A \$25 fee will be charged to switch sessions. Deposits are nonrefundable. A few weeks before your session, you and your child will receive a letter by mail from your dean (deans are volunteer program leaders) with details about your session.

What if I can't get online?

You may mail in hard-copy registration forms to the Pilgrim Lodge office. Registration forms are available online or by calling 207-724-3200.

What about Health Forms and Medication?

Health forms are required for everyone who stays at Pilgrim Lodge. Please see the Camper and Parent Guide for details. For youth, there is a form for parents to fill out, and another for a doctor to sign. We recommend completing the parent form online during the registration process (the doctor's form must still be hard copy). Forms must be renewed annually. All medications must be turned over to the Camp Nurse at registration in original containers with camper's name, name of medication, and usage instructions. Completed health forms are to be submitted to camp two weeks prior to the start of

What do we need to know about you or your camper?

Everyone is differently-abled. In order to us to help a camper have the best experience possible, the Director and your Dean need to be aware in advance of any physical, emotional, or behavioral issues a camper may have. While we are not equipped to handle every differently-abled camper, we will do our best to offer special support to as many campers as we can. If you have questions about the camp's ability to support a special need, please contact the Director before registering. All information shared with camp staff will be kept confidential.

Can my child request a friend be in the same cabin?

One of Pilgrim Lodge's core purposes is to build community. For this reason, we arrange cabins in a way so that campers will get to know one another. We also recognize coming to camp for the first time may cause your child to feel nervous. Campers have ample time to be with friends from home during option time, large group time and interest group time. We know this may cause some hesitancy, but our experience is that it is a way for campers to develop community and have a sense of independence. Please make us aware of any extenuating circumstances by contacting the Director.

What are the behavioral expectations?

We want campers to have a fun, safe, meaningful week at Pilgrim Lodge. Certain behaviors deemed inappropriate (including but not limited to: fighting, bullying, hitting, stealing, destruction of or intrusion into another's property, threatening another, refusal to eat, sexual activity, or possession or use of alcohol, illegal or misused drugs, or weapons) can result in the camper being sent home.

Please see the Parent and Camper guide for a list of what to bring, and what not to bring.

When are check-in and pickup?

Check-in is Sunday 2-4 p.m. unless you are notified differently in a deans' letter. No earlier than 2 p.m., no later than 4 p.m., please. Pickup is Saturday at 9:30 AM. Transportation to and from Pilgrim Lodge is the responsibility of the parents or guardians.
