Adi will be leading our evening program on the first night of camp to help us create something that we can put our names to and leave at PL



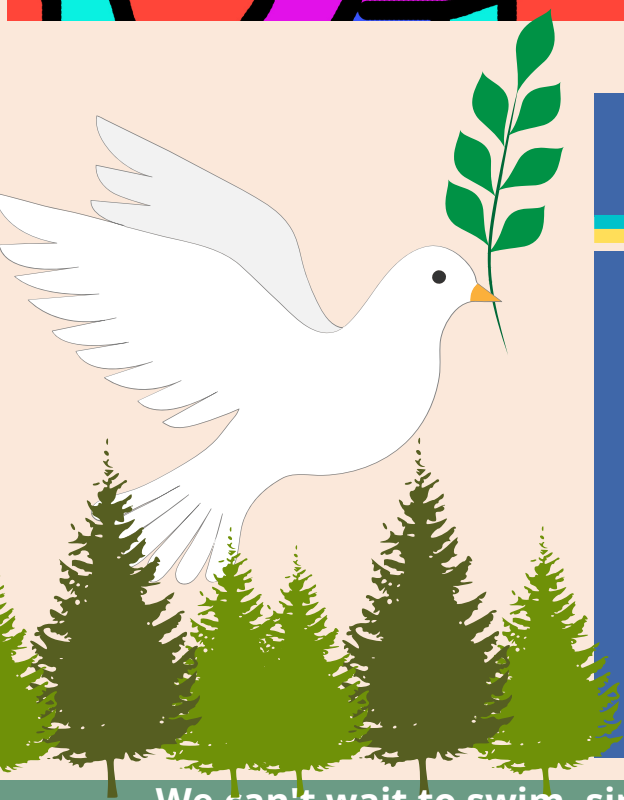
